In 2005, the Christmas SPIRIT Foundation began as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization to advance the spirit of Christmas year round for kids, families and the environment. Plans were soon developed for a national

Trees for Troops program, with FedEx providing the shipping and logistics for the Real Christmas Trees to be delivered to military bases across the U.S.
